Week 1. Create an information leaflet, web-page or fact-file on the author of the novel or play you are currently reading in your English lessons. The fact-file should be aimed at other people of your age.

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Week 2. Describe a scene from the novel or play you are reading. You should imagine that someone has taken a photo of a key moment in the novel for you to describe. Think about the range of devices and techniques you should use to bring your writing to life.

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Week 3. Imagine that you are one of the main characters in the novel or play you are reading with your class. You should write a journal (diary) entry or blog as if you are that character at this stage in the novel. Don't forget to explore the character's thoughts and feelings!

Week 4. Use the title of the novel or play you are studying as the title for your own short story. It must be no more than 250 words in length!

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Week 5. What are some of the themes and issues dealt with in the novel or play you have been studying? Write the script of an interview between you and a journalist in which you explain some of the main themes in the novel/play and how you feel about the issues explored.

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Week 6. Write a letter to the author of the book, giving your opinions on the story, characters and themes. You could also ask some questions on the novel or play.

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
